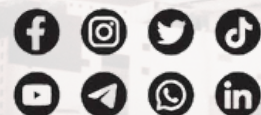

In a dynamic effort to boost civic engagements and electoral participation, Kick Corruption Out of Uganda (KICK-U), in collaboration with the Uganda National NGO Forum with support from USAID, scaled up and deepened impactful civic education initiatives such as Strengthening Citizens in Elections (SCENE). These initiatives are implemented in the districts of Kabale, Rubanda, Kanungu, Kisoro, Ntugamo, Rukungiri and Rukiga which intend to overcome the obstacles that hinder full citizenry participation in Uganda's electoral and other development processes.

KICK-U has conducted community meetings comprising of Fireplace, Topowa Forums and Media Conversations. These engagements are strategically organized to elevate community awareness about the Electoral and other planning processes in order to provide a space for citizens to express their concerns and demand for accountability for improved service delivery.

At these community meetings, diverse groups, including marginalized communities such as the Batwa in Ikamiro Parish, Muko Sub-county, Rubanda District, and residents of border districts like Kamwezi and Maziba Sub-counties, came together to discuss pressing development issues and chart way forward.

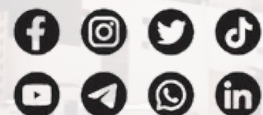

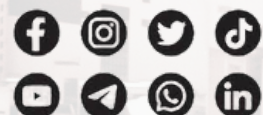
